Located 20 miles North of Chico, New Clairvaux Vineyards is the only winery maintained by a community of Cistercian Monks in North America. They have wine making knowledge dating back to the 12<sup>th</sup> century and are managed by a 5<sup>th</sup> generation CA winemaker, Aimee Sunseri.

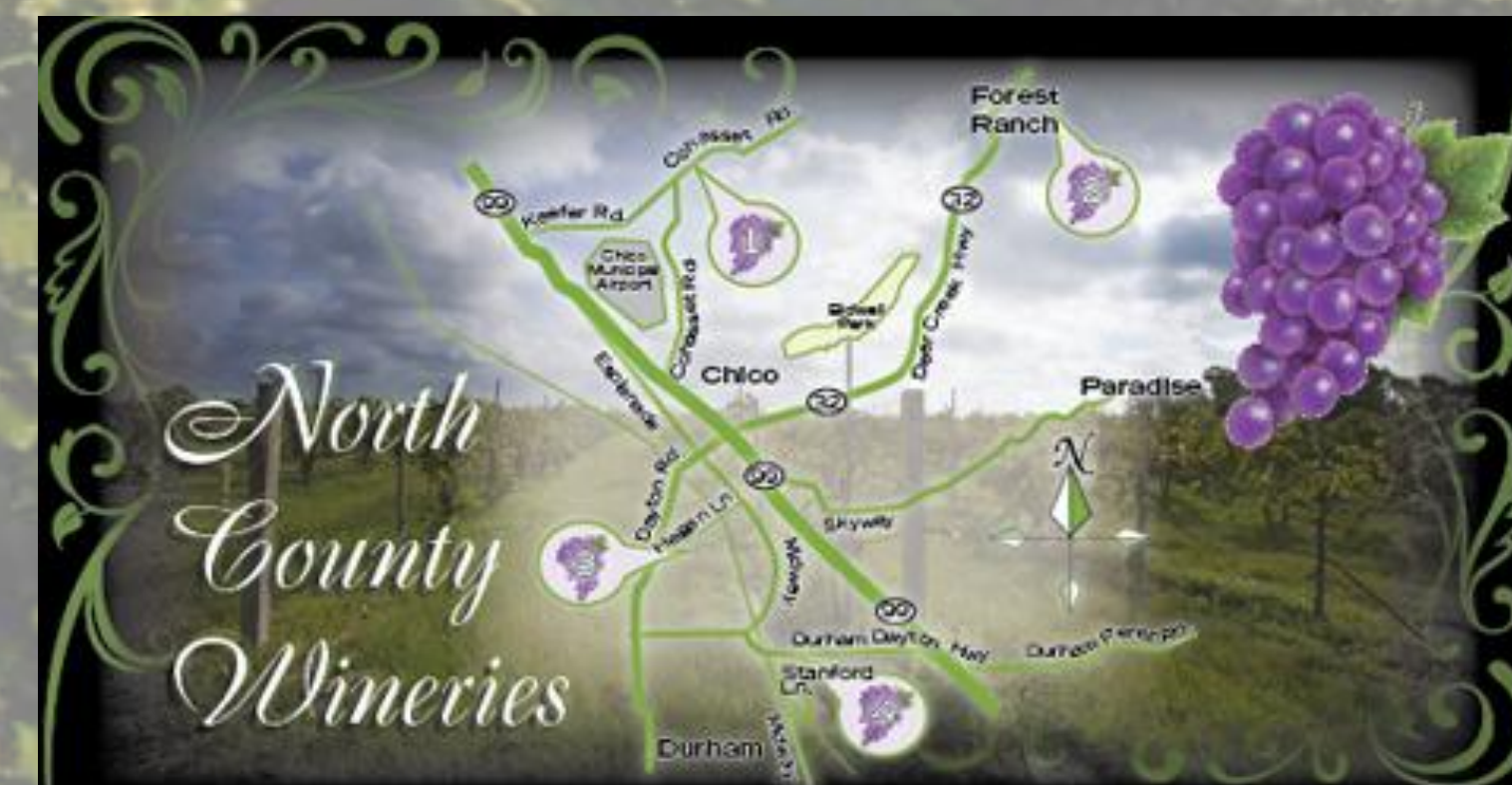
